Any request for exception to these rules must be made by the WHOA Region Director to the WHOA Referee-in-Chief. The WHOA Referee-in-Chief shall review the request. If the request is deemed to be valid, the WHOA Referee-in-Chief shall forward said request to the WAHA Vice President in charge of the tournament. The final decision regarding the request shall be made by the WAHA Vice President in charge of the tournament and shall be communicated to the WHOA Referee-in-Chief who will, in turn, communicate the decision to the WHOA Region Director.
